### JUROR

**Del-Bourree Bach** – A contemporary realist, Bach paints many subjects, from the sea, to rural farms and western vistas. Primarily a studio painter, he works in acrylic and transparent watercolor. Del's work is included in the Florence Griswold Museum in Connecticut, the Albrecht Kemper Museum in Missouri, and the Salmagundi Club in New York. He has received over 200 awards including the Robert Sanstrom Prize and Gold Medal from the National Society of Painter in Casein and Acrylic. In 2016 he was awarded Best Acrylic Painting, in the National Oil and Acrylic Painters Best of America and achieved Master Status, an honor shared by only a dozen living artists. Bach is a signature member of the American Society of Marine Artists, and the American Artists Professional League - Fellow. He is an elected artist member of the Salmagundi Club, Copley Society of Art - Master, and Lyme Art Association. Del's work has been featured in The Artists Magazine, International Artists-Master Painters of the World-2003, and Fine Art Connoisseur. His website is <https://del-bourreebach.com>.

### ELIGIBLE WORK

Water medium painting, unvarnished, under glass, by Connecticut artists. Painting may not exceed 34" in any direction, including frame. Painting must be framed, wired for hanging, and presented in a professional manner. No "brackets". Work not created with water media is ineligible. Light colored mat only (white, grey, tan, neutral colors). Artists' original work only. No copies or likenesses of other artists' work. No digital images or any form of reproduction. No work may be submitted which has been previously exhibited by the Connecticut Watercolor Society or Ely Center of Contemporary Art.

### SALES

A 35% commission will be charged on all sales. No P.O.R.

### LIABILITY

Neither C.W.S. nor the Ely Center of Contemporary Art, will be responsible for loss or damage to any work of art submitted from any cause whatsoever. All work is submitted and received subject to this condition.

### ENTRY FEES

Paid-up C.W.S. members may submit one or two paintings for \$20.00 total. C.W.S. members must pay all current and past dues prior to receiving day. Dues may not be paid on receiving day. C.W.S. members, who are not paid-up, will be charged non-member fees. Non-members may submit one painting for \$25.00 CASH ONLY, two paintings for \$35.00 CASH ONLY. Non-Members may not pay by check.

Work delivered personally, Saturday and Sunday, October 5th and 6th, 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., to the Ely Center of Contemporary Art, 51 Trumbull Street, New Haven, Connecticut.

### REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS

All declined work must be picked-up on Saturday, October 12th, 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. All paintings selected for the exhibition, must remain on display for the entire duration of the exhibition, including all purchases. Accepted work must be picked up on Sunday, November 10th, 3:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m., (paintings may not be removed before 3:00 p.m.), or Monday, November 11th, 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. Work left after Monday, November 11th, will be picked-up and stored by CWS. A \$10 storage fee will be charged for each painting put in storage.
