In 2008-2010, she was an artist mentor for the Graduate Program at the Art Institute of Boston. Her work has been included in group and solo shows all over the country and in Ireland. She has done mural work, which includes two Sol LeWitt wall drawings, and she has designed and executed murals in Nevada, Nantucket, and a six foot by forty-seven foot mural at Peppercorn's Grill in Hartford. Her work is included in many private and corporate collections including the Ruth and Marvin Sackner Archives of Visual Poetry, the New Britain Museum of American Art, The Sol and Carol LeWitt collection, the Chase Family collection and the Bushnell.
